5AM - 12/7

METRO'S GOING TO KEEP CAMERAS AT ITS PARKING FACILITIES... EVEN THOUGH A STUDY SAYS THEY AREN'T MAKING A DIFFERENCE IN CRIME. THAT'S ACCORDING TO THE WASHINGTON EXAMINER. THE TRANSIT AGENCY AND A D-C RESEARCH INSTITUTE REVIEWED 12 MONTHS OF DATA... AND FOUND THE CAMERAS DIDN'T DETER CRIME. A SPOKESPERSON SAYS THE CAMERAS ARE JUST ONE PART OF METRO'S APPROACH TO FIGHTING CRIME.

D-C LEADERS ARE EXPECTED TO ANNOUNCE PLANS TO IMPROVE POLICE SERVICE AND HIGHLIGHT CRIME-FIGHTING SUCCESSES FROM 20-11. TODAY'S NEWS CONFERENCE COMES AS THE DISTRICT COULD SEE ITS LOWEST MURDER RATE IN NEARLY A HALF-CENTURY. THERE HAVE BEEN 108-MURDERS IN 20-11... DOWN FROM 132 AT THIS TIME LAST YEAR. MAYOR VINCENT GRAY ATTRIBUTES THE DROP TO COMMUNITY POLICING AND STRONG POLICE LEADERSHIP.

VIOLENCE AND PORN...THAT'S WHAT SOME FACEBOOK USERS FOUND ON THEIR PROFILE TODAY. HACKERS REPORTEDLY TARGETED THE SITE OVERNIGHT.. FLOODING USERS' "NEWSFEEDS" WITH SPAM. SOME OF THE IMAGES SHOWED CELEBRITIES IN SEXUALLY SUGGESTIVE POSITIONS, OTHERS DEPICTED EXTREME VIOLENCE.. AND THERE WAS AT LEAST ONE PHOTO OF AN ABUSED DOG. FACEBOOK SAYS IT'S INVESTIGATING THE ISSUE.

5PM - 11/24

'TIS THE SEASON TO SHOP... BUT BEWARE: THIEVES ARE DOING THE SAME.. AT YOUR EXPENSE. TRIPLE-A SAYS THIEVES AND CARJACKERS ARE LURKING IN PARKING LOTS WAITING TO ATTACK CUSTOMERS AS THEY RETURN TO THEIR CARS. LAST YEAR, THERE WERE MORE THAN 35-THOUSAND REPORTED CAR BREAK-INS ON BLACK FRIDAY. OFFICIALS URGE SHOPPERS PAY ATTENTION ... STAY FOCUSED... AND AVOID DISTRACTIONS.

IT WAS A CRIME SPREE THAT TERRORIZED THE REGION -- NOW LAW ENFORCEMENT IS RE-INTENSIFYING THEIR EFFORTS TO SOLVE THOSE COLD CASES. TOMORROW - THE F--B-I WILL HOLD A NEWS CONFERENCE TO ASK FOR THE PUBLIC'S HELP TO FIND THE SO-CALLED "POTOMAC RIVER RAPIST." POLICE SAY HE KILLED ONE WOMAN AND RAPED AT LEAST

WE'RE FOLLOWING A DEVELOPING STORY FROM DUMFRIES -- WHERE POLICE ARE INVESTIGATING AN OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING. POLICE SAY AN OFFICER WAS FORCED TO SHOOT A MAN NEAR JEFFERSON DAVIS HIGHWAY AND BRADYS HILL ROAD THIS AFTERNOON -- AFTER HE WALKED TOWARDS THE OFFICER WITH A GUN. THE SUSPECT DIED AT THE SCENE. NO OFFICERS WERE HURT. THE INVESTIGATION IS CAUSING MAJOR TRAFFIC BACK-UPS IN THE AREA. WE HAVE A CREW ON THE WAY -- AND WE'LL BRING YOU MORE DETAILS AS THEY BECOME AVAILABLE.

## **LOCAL GOVERNMENT**

4:30A - 10/17

THE MARYLAND GENERAL ASSEMBLY WILL BEGIN A SPECIAL SESSION ON MONDAY IN ANNAPOLIS. THE STATE'S 141 DELEGATES AND 47 SENATORS WILL VOTE ON THE CONGRESSIONAL RE-DISTRICTING PLAN. IT'S REQUIRED TO HAPPEN BEFORE THE START OF THE 2012 REGULAR SESSION AND BEFORE THE STATE'S APRIL PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY. LAWMAKERS MAY ALSO DISCUSS THE STATE'S STRUCTURAL DEFICIT AND TRANSPORTATION ISSUES.

5AM - 11/1

THE D.C. COUNCIL WILL CONSIDER AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION OPPOSING INTERFERENCE BY CONGRESS IN LOCAL AFFAIRS. COUNCIL MEMBER MARY CHEH PLANS TO INTRODUCE THE MEASURE TODAY. IT'S INTENDED AS A RESPONSE TO A BILL INTRODUCED YESTERDAY IN THE HOUSE.. THAT WOULD REQUIRE CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR MAYORAL APPOINTEES IN THE DISTRICT.

5AM - 11/15

EIGHT D-C STATEHOOD ACTIVISTS ARRESTED WHILE PROTESTING ON CAPITOL HILL EARLIER THIS YEAR ARE SCHEDULED TO GO ON TRIAL TODAY. THEY'RE CHARGED WITH UNLAWFUL ASSEMBLY AND FAILURE TO OBEY AN OFFICER. THE EIGHT WERE AMONG 72-PEOPLE ARRESTED IN APRIL WHILE PROTESTING CONGRESSIONAL INTERFERENCE IN D-C AFFAIRS. THEY'RE EXPECTED TO APPEAR AT A RALLY OUTSIDE D-C SUPERIOR COURT BEFORE THEIR TRIAL.

5AM - 11/30

A D-C COUNCIL COMMITTEE WILL TAKE UP A COMPREHENSIVE ETHICS REFORM BILL TODAY. THE LEGISLATION WOULD ESTABLISH AN INDEPENDENT PANEL THAT COULD PUNISH COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR VIOLATIONS. IT WOULD REDUCE THE AMOUNT COUNCIL MEMBERS CAN RAISE FOR THEIR CONSTITUENT SERVICE FUNDS AND RESTRICT HOW THE MONEY CAN BE SPENT. LAWMAKERS WOULD ALSO BE REQUIRED TO DISCLOSE ALL OUTSIDE INCOME.

5AM - 12/14

A D-C COUNCIL COMMITTEE WILL HOLD A HEARING ON A BILL TO REGULATE TATTOO AND BODY PIERCING ARTISTS. THE BILL WOULD REQUIRE ARTISTS AND PARLORS TO BE LICENSED... AND SET STANDARDS FOR PEOPLE WHO WORK AT THOSE BUSINESSES. D-C IS ONE OF THE LAST PLACES IN THE COUNTRY WHERE TATTOO AND PIERCING PARLORS ARE NOT REGULATED.

6AM -11/9

A FEDERAL JURY HAS FOUND MARYLAND STATE SENATOR ULYSSES CURRIE NOT GUILTY OF CORRUPTION CHARGES. BUT THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY LAWMAKER WILL STILL FACE AN ETHICS INVESTIGATION IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY. PROSECUTORS ACCUSED THE 74-YEAR-OLD DEMOCRAT OF BRIBERY AND EXTORTION FOR ACCEPTING MONEY TO ADVOCATE FOR A GROCERY STORE. THE DEFENSE CALLED HIS ACTIONS A CONFLICT OF INTEREST... BUT SAID THEY WERE NOT CRIMINAL BECAUSE THEY WERE NOT SECRET. CURRIE CALLED HIS EXONERATION THE GREATEST MOMENT OF HIS LIFE.

5PM - 11/2

ONE D-C COUNCIL MEMBER WANTS DRIVERS IN THE CITY -- TO SLOW DOWN COUNCILWOMAN MURIEL BOWSER IS PROPOSING A NEW LAW THAT WOULD LOWER SPEED LIMITS ON RESIDENTIAL ROADS FROM 25 TO 15 MILES PER HOUR BOWSER SAYS WORRIES OVER SPEEDING DRIVERS HAS DISCOURAGED RESIDENTS FROM WALKING AND RIDING BIKES IN NEIGHBORHOODS. THE PROPOSAL WOULD EXEMPT ARTERIAL ROADS IN THE DISTRICT.

11PM - 10/5

A HEALTH GROUP IS PLANNING TO PUSH FOR A ONE DOLLAR INCREASE IN MARYLAND'S TOBACCO TAX. THE MARYLAND CITIZENS' HEALTH INITIATIVE SAYS IT WANTS A TAX HIKE TO HELP PAY FOR PUBLIC HEALTH NEEDS. MARYLAND LAST RAISED THE TAX IN 2007 TO TWO DOLLARS A PACK. THE GROUP WILL LAUNCH THEIR CAMPAIGN NEXT WEEK.

## **SUBSTANCE ABUSE**

4:30AM - 12/28

THE HEAD OF A CHANTILLY PAIN MANAGEMENT CENTER IS FACING A NUMBER OF DRUG AND GUN CHARGES THIS MORNING. PROSECUTORS SAY PAUL BOCCONE -- PRESIDENT OF CHANTILLY SPECIALISTS OF VIRGINIA -- ILLEGALLY PRESCRIBED OVER 800-THOUSAND OXYCONTIN PILLS LAST YEAR. BOCCONE HAS NO MEDICAL LICENSE. ANOTHER CENTER EMPLOYEE WAS ALSO ARRESTED. AUTHORITIES SAY PEOPLE DROVE HUNDREDS OF MILES TO OBTAIN THE DRUGS.

WE'RE LEARNING MORE ABOUT A YEAR-LONG DRUG INVESTIGATION THAT LED TO 70 ARRESTS. D.C. POLICE AND FEDERAL AGENTS COLLECTED 161 GUNS.. AND MORE THAN SEVEN-MILLION DOLLARS WORTH OF DRUGS. YESTERDAY.. THEY SHOWED OFF THE LOOT THEY CONFISCATED. THEY SAY THEY SET UP A PHONY RECORDING STUDIO LAST YEAR.. WHERE UNDERCOVER AGENTS PURCHASED GUNS AND DRUGS. POLICE SAY SEVERAL OF THOSE ARRESTED HAVE TIES TO MEXICAN DRUG CARTELS

5PM - 12/12

A PRINCE WILLIAM COUNTY SURGEON IS IN JAIL, ACCUSED OF ILLEGALLY DEALING PRESCRIPTION DRUGS. POLICE ARRESTED DR. ALEX YUH-DOW AT HIS TRIANGLE OFFICE EARLIER TODAY. AUTHORITIES SAY YADAO WAS WRITING FRAUDULENT PRESCRIPTIONS FOR UP TO EIGHT-THOUSAND PILLS A WEEK, INCLUDING OXYCONTIN AND MORPHINE FOR THOSE WILLING TO PAY.

6PM - 10/28

TOMORROW--PEOPLE ACROSS THE AREA CAN TURN IN EXPIRED OR UNUSED PRESCRIPTION DRUGS. IT'S PART OF THE NATIONWIDE DRUG TAKE-BACK DAY. THE GOAL IS TO PREVENT DRUG ABUSE... AND KEEP DANGEROUS MEDICATIONS OUT OF THE GROUNDWATER. FOLKS CAN DROP OFF THE DRUGS AT SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENTS AND POLICE STATIONS. TODAY - FAIRFAX COUNTY POLICE RAIDED MORE THAN A DOZEN BUSINESSES IN A MAJOR COUNTERFEIT DRUG BUST. OFFICERS SEIZED THOUSANDS OF DOSES OF ILLEGAL PAINKILLERS, ANTI-BIOTICS AND BIRTH CONTROL PILLS. THE CRACK-DOWN COMES AFTER A SIX-MONTH STING...BUT POLICE SAY THEY INCREASED THEIR EFFORTS AFTER A WOMAN BECAME VIOLENTLY ILL FROM THE COUNTER-FEIT PRESCRIPTIONS A FEW MONTHS AGO. MARYLAND STATE POLICE ARE CHECKING WHETHER ALCOHOL PLAYED A FACTOR IN A DEADLY CRASH IN TEMPLE HILLS. POLICE SAY BYRON HILTON WAS KILLED EARLY THIS MORNING WHEN HIS JEEP OVERTURNED. THE ACCIDENT HAPPENED ON A RAMP LEADING TO THE BELTWAY IN TEMPLE HILLS. OFFICERS FOUND ALCOHOL AT THE SCENE BUT THEY SAY IT'S UNCLEAR IF THAT CONTRIBUTED TO THE CRASH.

## **HOUSING & HOMELESSNESS**

4:30A - 10/19

LOUISA COUNTY, VIRGINIA, IS STILL TRYING TO GET FEDERAL AID FOR PEOPLE WHOSE HOMES WERE DAMAGED BY THE AUGUST EARTHQUAKE. MEANTIME, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS VOTED TO PASS THE BROADEST TAX RELIEF POSSIBLE FOR THOSE HOMEOWNERS. OFFICIALS SAY DAMAGE TO HOMES TOTALS ABOUT 18-MILLION DOLLARS. ONLY TWO% OF THAT LOSS IS COVERED BY INSURANCE.

4:30A - 10/31

SOME LOCAL STUDENTS FORCED FROM THEIR DORM ROOMS BY MOLD.. WILL BE MOVING INTO A CRUISE SHIP NEAR CAMPUS TODAY. ABOUT 350 STUDENTS AT ST. MARY'S COLLEGE OF MARYLAND WERE EVACUATED, AFTER A MOLD OUTBREAK IN TWO DORM BUILDINGS. THE SCHOOL HAD PUT THEM UP IN HOTELS.... BUT SCHOOL OFFICIALS SAY HOUSING THEM ON "THE SEA VOYAGER" WILL COST ABOUT THE SAME. THE STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO LIVE ON THE SHIP UNTIL DECEMBER.

BILLIONAIRE DONALD TRUMP WILL BE IN VIRGINIA \*\*TOMORROW\*\* TO MARK THE OPENING OF HIS VINEYARD NEAR CHARLOTTESVILLE.
