But it was unclear what Obama would pursue or how, and aides said stricter gun laws would be only part of any effort.

The president called on Congress Wednesday to reinstate an assault weapons ban that expired in 2004 and to pass legislation that would close the gun show "loophole," which allows people to purchase firearms from private dealers without a background check. Obama also said he wanted Congress to pursue the possibility of limiting high-capacity ammunition clips. The president's announcement Wednesday underscores the urgency the White House sees in formulating a response to the Newtown shooting. The massacre has prompted several congressional gun rights supporters to consider new legislation to control firearms, and there is some concern that their willingness to engage could fade as the shock and sorrow over the Newtown shooting eases. Obama said it was "encouraging" to see people of different backgrounds and political affiliations coming to an understanding that the country has an obligation to prevent such violence.

### **DEPORTED BY ICE IN 2012**

U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Director John Morton today announced the agency's fiscal year (FY) 2012 year-end removal numbers, highlighting trends that underscore the administration's focus on removing from the country convicted criminals and other individuals that fall into priority areas for enforcement. To further focus ICE resources on the most serious criminal offenders, ICE today also issued new national detainer guidance. This guidance limits the use of detainers to individuals who meet the department's enforcement priorities and restricts the use of detainers against individuals arrested for minor misdemeanor offenses such as traffic offenses and other petty crimes, helping to ensure that available resources are focused on apprehending felons, repeat offenders and other ICE priorities. It is applicable to all ICE enforcement programs, including Secure Communities.

### **GUN SALES USA**

Despite the outrage and cries for more gun control legislation in the United States, some retailers are still making big sales with Christmas right around the corner. Calls for tougher legislation are getting louder as gun sales soar. Data from the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) show that 16.4 million background checks, a rough proxy for gun demand, were run nationwide in 2011. Last month, the FBI recorded about two million background checks on prospective gun buyers, the highest monthly total ever, up 1.5 million from November 2011. While some big retailers have stopped selling assault rifles like the AR-15, in Houston, privately owned gun stores are selling them so fast, that they cannot keep them on the shelves.

## **US HOLIDAY RETAIL SALES GROWTH WEAKEST SINCE 2008**

U.S. holiday retail sales this year are the weakest since 2008, after a shopping season disrupted by storms and rising uncertainty among consumers. A report out Tuesday that tracks spending, called MasterCard Advisors SpendingPulse, says holiday sales increased 0.7 percent. Analysts had expected sales to grow 3 to 4 percent. Much of the shortfall comes from Superstorm Sandy, which caused sales declines after striking the East Coast in late October. And consumers grew increasingly nervous as lawmakers failed to reach a deal to head off tax increases and government spending cuts set to take effect in early 2013. The SpendingPulse number tracks sales of popular holiday goods, including electronics, jewelry and clothing, in the two months before Christmas. That's a crucial period for retailers.

The simple gun ownership process and lax gun control are blamed for rampant shooting in the United States. There are more than 270 million private guns registered in the United States, compared with its 300 million population. In the 50 states in USA, there are some 130,000 shops that can trade guns legally. In those shops, one only needs to show the ID card and the gun holder certificate to take the gun and bullet back home. To make things easier, it only costs ten U.S. dollars to apply for Firearm Owner's Identification Program (FOID) card in Illinois State. The applicants have to fill a form to obtain the FOID card, which requires the basic information, as well as answers to question like "Are you addicted to narcotics? Are you intellectually disabled?". Not surprisingly, the answers are basically the same among most applicants.

## FISCAL CLIFF

The Senate's top Republican says President Barack Obama has asked congressional leaders to convene at the White House for last-minute talks on a deal that avoids automatic tax increases and broad spending cuts. Senate Minority Leader Mitch McConnell says the leaders are expected to meet with the president Friday, just four days before the government goes over the so-called "fiscal cliff" if Congress and Obama don't act. The meeting would be the first time Obama has huddled with all four leaders since Nov. 16 and would represent that last hope for a deal before the new year. Obama spoke to each leader individually Wednesday before returning from vacation in Hawaii. Obama and congressional Democrats want a deal that would let tax rates rise for the wealthiest taxpayers.

## NEW HOME SALES RISE

New home sales jumped in November to the highest level in more than two years. The U.S. government is reporting an increase last month rose 4-point-4-percent compared to October. It's the strongest pace of new home sales since April of 20-10. The increase is due to a combination of near-record low mortgage rates, lower unemployment numbers and a drop in foreclosures. That in turn has lifted home prices. The housing market is now showing numerous signs of recovery, including better existing home sales and home construction rates.
