- (2) **POLITICS:** COMMUNITY WANTING ETHICAL POLITICIANS AND FEEL THE NEED TO BE EDUCATED ON LOCAL/REGIONAL ISSUES THAT EFFECT THEIR DAILY LIVES.

The book is written from the volunteer cold case investigators' point of views.
