April-June 2009

For this Quarterly Report, KTVA covered numerous issues that were highly significant to our viewers.

We started off this Quarter with a major upset in the on-going Federal corruption investigation of Alaskan Legislators. The Justice Department dismissed the case against former U.S. Senator Ted Stevens. This decision has had a trickle down impact on the investigation as a whole. Most recently in June, two other convicted former legislators, Pete Kott and Vic Kohring, were released from federal prison due to the problems in Stevens case.

Politics continued to dominate April, as Anchorage had to choose from a list of 15 people for the job of mayor. The race was too close to call between the top two candidates. A runoff election took place in May and Anchorage elected Dan Sullivan, as it's next mayor. Former Mayor Mark Begich was elected U.S. Senator...beating Ted Stevens.

The new mayor wasn't taking over until July 1st. However, Acting-Mayor Matt Claman, who was a candidate for mayor, announced major budget shortfalls for the city. Over the course of the next several months, Claman announced mandatory furloughs, fire station closures and layoffs.

April also brought to an end the 2009 Legislative Session. The State faced shifting revenue forecasts, which

meant budgets for 2010 and 2011 needed to be adjusted. Oil prices continued to stay low which is a huge chunk of

A rockslide shut down the Whittier Tunnel trapping the small community from the rest of the State. The Alaska Railroad was used to help shuttle people in and out of the town.

The State also experienced a fight between Legislators and Governor Palin over stimulus monies from the Federal Government. Palin rejected almost all of the funds. Many social services protested against the decision by Palin. Palin later on adjusted her rejection.

As the swine flu took a hold of the rest of the world. Alaska remained isolated for the first couple of months. But the State began to see cases turn up and set up a testing center in Fairbanks. Anchorage set up it's own command center along with the State.

The spring thaw sent record floods down the Yukon and Kuskokwim Rivers. Many villages were destroyed and communities left devastated by the destruction. The communities were declared disasters. F.E.M.A. was brought in to help residents and have them sign up for Federal assistance.

Acting Mayor Claman introduced an anti-discrimination ordinance for Anchorage. It brought out record crowds to the Assembly meeting. So many people signed up to testify that the ordinance didn't get voted on before Claman transferred power. The issue is now going before the new Mayor Dan Sullivan.

Governor Palin made a surprise move in June in regards to the Natural Gas Pipeline project. She worked out a new agreement that includes Exxon Mobil. Transcanada and Exxon Mobil will now work together to built Alaska's Natural Gas Pipeline.

The Alaska ACES made it to the Kelly Cup Finals this year. The series went to the seventh game. The ACES ended up losing.

The digital television switch finally took place. It was originally set for February but postponed until June. We re-educated the viewer on what they needed to know and do about the switch.

The Federal Government is cutting the Defense Department's budget due to the Recession. Some of those cuts involve the Missile Defense project in Alaska. Secretary of Defense, Robert Gates, came up to Alaska for a tour and to reassure Alaska's defenses are secure.

The Knik Arm Bridget project was up for a vote in June. The projects future has been up for debate for years. The Mayors of Wasilla and Houston filed a lawsuit against the City of Anchorage over the project. The judge has delayed a ruling until July. The Assembly voted to change the project end date to a later date.

Between May and June, seven bodies have turned up in Anchorage. The bodies were that of men and majority homeless. The autopsy reports came back with nothing suspicious.

This year's low salmon count is forcing many lakes and rivers to be shutdown. The police are even ticketing people for illegal fishing. The biggest closure is at Ship Creek in downtown Anchorage.
