July-September 2009:

For this Quarterly Report, KTVA covered numerous issues that were highly significant to our viewers.

July kicked off with Governor Sarah Palin saying that she will resign as governor at the end of the month. This brought into question about who's going to run the State and how much authority does she have in the process? Palin cited one of the reasons she was resigning were the many ethic complaints filed against her. Palin stepped down on July 26th saying that it was a good thing for Alaska.

Anchorage's homeless problem continued. The city racked up its 8th death in less than two months. By the end of the month, Mayor Sullivan said he is working on a plan to address the problem.

Interior and Kenai Peninsula wildfires continued to pound the State. The Kenai wildfire grew to over 13,000 acres. The interior fires caused so much smoke that air quality advisories and warnings were issued for Anchorage. Visibility became less than manageable for aircrafts.

For the first time in 6 years, the minimum wage for Alaska went up. It jumped 10 cents to \$7.25 an hour. It will increase again in January by 50 cents.

By the end of the month, Mayor Sullivan outlined his needs on budget cuts for Anchorage. He announced that he sent his suggestions to his department heads. He said

he is charging them with coming up with ways to find savings and implement budget cuts.

August kicked off with the Federal Government giving Alaska an "F" when it comes No Child Left Behind requirements.

The Alaska Legislature held a special session to decide whether or not to override Former Governor Palin's veto of the energy stimulus monies. The Legislature voted to override.

The Anti-Discrimination Ordinance for Anchorage came to a vote this month. It passed but not enough for it to go in front of the Mayor for a possible veto. Assembly Chairperson, Debbie Ossiander, was the swing vote to avoid a veto. Sullivan vetoed the ordinance.

The town hall health care forums took center stage here in Alaska. Hundreds of people showed up to Senator Lisa Murkowski's meetings to hear and give their two cents on reforming health care in America.

At the end of the month, Mayor Sullivan released his plan to address homeless in Anchorage. It came on the heels of the record number of homeless deaths in the last three months. Sullivan cited alcohol as the leading focus to deal with the problem.

September kicked off with the Anchorage School District being swamped with complaints about President Obama making a speech to students. Obama was speaking about the importance to education and staying in school. Some parents decided to not send their children to school

b/c they believed it was inappropriate for a President to push a political agenda.

Alaska saw it's third H1N1 death in September.

More problems followed new Anchorage Mayor Dan Sullivan. He faced criticism for changing the name of the annual diversity dinner to the first annual unity dinner. It split the Assembly down party lines. Both dinners had record turnout.

A 17-year-old girl was shot and killed in Muldoon while attending a party. Neighbors complained to police about the noise from the party but didn't responded until shots were fired. The shooting was a drive by and the girl was an innocent victim. There were reports that adults were attending the party or even owners of the home allowed the underage partying to take place but police were unable to find any proof.

Mayor Sullivan unveiled his budget for 2010. He says he used the suggestions he got from his department heads for proposed budget cuts. Sullivan also added that the budget shortfall for this year was eliminated.

We broke the story about human remains being found in the valley. It was discovered at a construction site. The bones were from a native burial site. Officials weren't going to do anything about it until we reported it. Instead, they were going to go ahead with construction and not let family members know.
