Quarterly Summary: October 2009-December 2009

October began with the arrival of the H1N1 vaccines to Alaska. We broke the story and got exclusive access when the vaccine arrived. However, later in the month not enough shipments got to Alaska and thus forced many government agencies to change up it's vaccination plans. One of the biggest impacts of the change involved the Anchorage School District. By the end of the month, emergency rooms and doctor offices were flooded with people wanted to get vaccinated.

Also in October, Anchorage's Homeless Leadership Team met for the first time to figure out the problem. Over the spring and summer, bodies of homeless people started turning up shedding light on the state of homeless in Anchorage.

By the end of the month, the two men at the center of the Alaska corruption cases were sentenced. Former Veco executives, Rick Smith and Bill Allen, were key witnesses in all of corruption trials. Allen was sentenced to three years in prison with a maximum 750-thousand dollar fine and Smith got a 21 month jail sentence and a 10-thousand dollar fine.

In November, the month began with another veto from Anchorage Mayor Dan Sullivan. He vetoed an Assembly suggestion to pass 15-million dollars of State money onto property tax payers. At the same time, the public comment period on Sullivan's budget plan for 2010 was on the table. Sullivan also was involved in the finger pointing

investigation into former mayor and current U.S. Senator Mark Begich's involvement in the budget shortfall.

We did a special week long series on the state of sex education in Alaska. We examined how sex was being taught in the Anchorage School District, the divisive abortion debate and parental consent bills in the legislature and how teens view sex education and what advice they'd give their parents.

The health care debate heated up with a public plea from President Barack Obama. He made an 11th hour appeal to the American people on the positive impacts of reform. The next day, the health care proposal headed to the Senate for review and eventual vote.

We broke the story about the 15million dollar budget shortage the Anchorage School District is facing next year. The ASD came up with a budget proposal and began public forums with the community to discuss. Not very many people attended.

Right before Thanksgiving, an Anchorage woman was behind the wheel of a fatal dui accident. Her name is Lori Phillips and her significance is this isn't the first time she's been served a DUI. We took a look at how Lori Phillips wasn't behind bars and how do current laws stand up to repeat DUI offenders.

November ended with another oil spill on the North Slope involving BP. This time the spill was near one of it's Prudhoe Bay fields.

December started off with the continued clean-up of the BP spill. We took a look at BP's past environmental charges and fines on the North Slope. We found that BP is still on probation for earlier problems from spills. This latest spill became one of the worst in state history.

Governor Sean Parnell unveiled his plan to end the growing problem of domestic violence and sexual assault in Alaska. A few days later, a female student at Service High School was stabbed multiple times by her ex-boyfriend who is also a student at Service High. We ended up taking another look at Alaska's long history of domestic violence and why.

An explosion rocked the natural gas plant at Point MacKenzie. No one was injured. One of its maintenance buildings was completely destroyed.

Right before the Christmas holiday, the U.S. Senate voted to approve its health care reform bill. Alaska's two senators were split on the issue. Mark Begich voted in favor of the bill and Lisa Murkowski voted against.

We broke the story about an out-of-state company hiring illegal immigrants to work in Alaska. The location of the work was on Elemendorf Air Force Base and the project...the new F-22 hangar.

Anchorage residents were victims of a credit/debit card security breach at a local restaurant. Their numbers were stolen and used to make purchases on the east coast of the Lower 48.

And the end of the month, year ended with a tug boat accident in the same local of the Exxon Valdez oil spill. Investigators were sure how much of the 93-thousand gallons of diesel fuel spilled into the water.
