Quarterly Summary: January 2010-March 2010

January:

The big story for January was an Anchorage Police officer being shot by an ambush. Officer Jason Allen was handling a domestic call in Fairview when an SUV rolled up and starting shooting as the cop sat in his police vehicle. This was the first time an officer was shot in the line of duty in years. This story would continue to unravel all month long. Allen remained under protective care as he recovered in the hospital. Police don't have a suspects and the community rallied behind Allen by conducting fundraisers. We also did an expose' of the gang situation in Anchorage since the shooting may be gang related.

The earthquake in Haiti had local connections up here. We were first to report on a brother and sister from Anchorage who were victims in the quake. The Red Cross and Salvation Army sent local teams to assist. We found a local doctor from the Mat-Su Valley who also left for Haiti to volunteer his services. We also touched potential scams that people would want to donate money could get ripped off.

There was a fire at an air cargo facility for Frontier Airlines in Aniak. The facility is a huge hub for distributing cargo through out Alaska. It disrupted not only goods but also mail service as well throughout the state.

The Anchorage School District unveiled its proposed budget for 2010. We broke the story last year that it was facing 15million dollar shortfall. The budget was revised and was now being presented to the public for review and comments.

Governor Sean Parnell made his first State of the State Address to the Legislature toward the end of January. This was his first time as Governor. He outlined his projects but also used it as an opportunity to step out from the shadow of former Governor Sarah Palin. He is running for re-election.

We ended January with more than 77,000 Alaska state employees at risk of identity theft. There was a security breach within the state's computer system. It happened as the state was using an outside law firm to help out with an on-going lawsuit.

February kicked off with the Toyota recall. We localized what was happening here in Anchorage as a result of the recall. We spoke with dealers and customers.

The Anchorage School District had its final public comment and final vote on its 2010 budget. It's passed.

We started a series called Cold Case. We profiled four murder investigations that went "cold." It gained a lot of viewer response. We also took a look at the problems facing these cases...one of which was the State crime lab. The lab is over capacity and needs to expand. There's currently a fight going on with lawmakers on how best to upgrade the facility. In the meantime, investigators say its making solving cold cases very challenging.

Over Valentine's Day weekend, we had several avalanches in the area. Several people were killed including the president of ConocoPhillips for Alaska. Jim Bowles was a huge community support outside of his work for

ConocoPhillips. We had several warm-ups during the month so it made the danger of avalanches' very high.

We did an exclusive interview with Joshua Wade over his plea agreement in the murders of Della Brown and Mindy Schloss. Wade was facing the death penalty but not anymore after the agreement. We spoke with Wade after his court appearance from jail.

We did another week long series at the end of the month on the state of education in Anchorage. We took a look at the performance level in public schools and how the schools are rated. We also took a look at what the alternative schools are such as private, charter and home schooling. We also did an investigation of why there aren't any law or medical schools in Anchorage since that's a growing sector of employment.

We ended the month with a shooting and murder at a local mall. Someone shot and killed a man inside the Dimond Center Mall on the last Saturday of the month. At first police thought they caught the suspect but it turned out to be the victims friend. Police released a description of the suspect as a man wearing a wig.

March continued with the Dimond Center murder investigation. Police released information on three people of interest in the case. One of people of interest turned out to be the suspect. He was arrested later in the month. It turned out he and the victim had a dispute over a video game and was meeting at the mall to figure it out.

The 2010 Iditarod kicked off at the beginning of March. We covered the start of the race in Anchorage and the restart

in Willow. Lance Mackey ended up winning his fourth championship.

A school teacher in the village of Chignik Lake was killed. She went jogging and residents found her chewed up body. Investigators believe she was killed by a pack of wolves. The state went on the hunt to locate the wolves and held a public meeting. We also took a look at wolf attacks statewide and if there is a cause for concern.

Muni Elections are up for the first Tuesday of next month. We did a two-week series on everything that voters are going asked to vote on. We profiled the six propositions and all the candidates. We also took a look at the young faces popping up in local elections. We ended the series with an investigation into the cost of running an election.

March also wrapped up with the vote on the health care bill by congress and signage into law by the President. We did local reax from our congressional delegation. We also broke out what this bill means for the average person. We took a look at what changes people will see and what changes they won't change.
