Quarterly Report for April 2010-June 2010:
Significant issues covered by News

April 2010:

Anchorage has cut several after school programs in an effort to make up for budget shortfalls. The lower income areas are being hit especially hard; families there can't afford to pay for their kids to take part in activities that are going to cost them money. The free after school programs were a great way to keep their kids out of trouble.

We continued our exclusive story on the problems involving the Lucky Times Lotto. We got tips that the state was able to uncover the organizer's criminal past and how he's trying to postpone the lottery. It's a lottery that was going to make a significant donation to STAR...a local domestic violence non-profit.

We broke the story about deicer problems at the Ted Stevens International Airport. The airport doesn't have a system in place to deal with used deicer. It just flows right into the Cook Inlet. We uncovered that the airport has been warned about this in the past and done nothing about it. We also found the deicer was killing fish which could have an effect on the Beluga Whale population.

Alaska joined numerous other states to sue the federal government over the health care reform legislation passed earlier this year in Congress.

May 2010:

We did a five part series at the beginning of the month. It was called "Caring For Your Parents" and looked at all the different issues that adult children face when having to take care of their elderly parents. We personalized it by sharing the unknown stories of some well-known community figures that had found themselves responsible for the well being of their mothers or fathers.

We continued our look at sex offenders in Anchorage. We found 13-sex offenders...all who had committed crimes against children living within one mile of a local elementary school. Our story brought attention to the fact Alaska doesn't have a law specifying how close sex offenders can be to children.

We did a two part series on the function of Amber Alerts. There is a general lack of knowledge in how the alerts worked. We focused on the

importance of teaching your kids what to do if a stranger approaches them. We also focused on exactly how the alert is activated and why.

May kicks off summer unofficially for Alaska. With that comes an increase of a certain type of vehicle on the road. Motorcycles. Alaska has one of the highest motorcycle riding populations in the country. The warmer weather means more bikes are on the road. We took a personal spin on the story and profiled one of our own who was hit while riding a motorcycle.

June 2010:

Wildfire season ran wild for the beginning of this month. Due to the lack of rain during the month of May, Alaska's conditions were extremely dry. Alaska had the most and biggest wildfires in the country. We took a look at what's going on and why our conditions are so dry.

We did an investigation into the challenges of 911 dispatch. We touched on a big issue facing dispatchers, which is false calls, or calls that don't need to come to 911.

Governor Parnell axed funding for Denali Kid Care because he said he heard it funding some forms of abortions. We took a look at how the pull out of funding was going to impact those who benefit from DKC. We also looked into the abortion funding and found that it was for medical reasons only.

For the second time in six months, an Anchorage Police Officer was shot while in the line of duty. The officer was doing a routine traffic stop with she was shot. It happened exactly six months to the day when another officer was shot in January. We dug deeper into crime against law enforcement and what's going on. We ask city leaders about the changes in funding for the police department and if things would change. The suspect for the first officer shooting is still at large.

National mortgage rates are down but it's always different for Alaska. We took a look into the local housing market and if there were signs of any change.

We traveled up to Red Dog Mine and profiled the ongoing project. We also dug into the community impact the mine was having on the local economy and culture. We also reported on the struggle between the mine and environmentalists who say the mine is more problematic than beneficial.

We had five people die due to shellfish poisoning. We found out that since fishing is a huge recreational sport in Alaska, it's difficult to regulate. Most of the deaths were occurring from non-regulated fish. We also looked into how the state is testing fish to understand why this is happening.
