Created by KSL 5 TV, Weather Lab is a weather/science program. It is suited mainly to grade levels 3-6 and airs in conjunction with the 4<sup>th</sup> Grade weather curriculum in Utah schools.

During each session of Weather Lab, school children, their teachers, administrators and parents visit KSL Television to participate in Weather Lab with KSL Meteorologist Len Randolph. The program airs twice weekly on Eyewitness News at Noon and attracts a diverse group of students representing Wasatch Front schools in a wide geographic area.
