## **THIRD QUARTER WEATHER LABS**

Created by KSL 5 Television, Weather Lab is a weather/science program. It is suited mainly to grade levels 4-6 and airs in conjunction with the 4<sup>th</sup> Grade weather curriculum in Utah schools.

During each session of Weather Lab, school children, their teachers, administrators and parents go to Discovery Gateway, a Salt Lake City-based children's museum, to meet with KSL Meteorologist Grant Weyman to learn about science, weather and broadcasting. Each group and experiment is taped for future on-air use.

The experiments air the week of the taping on KSL 5 News at Noon and attract a diverse group of students representing Wasatch Front schools in a wide geographic area. Schools participating come from the public, private, charter, web-based and home school sectors.

Weather Lab students are given the opportunity to share with viewers what they've learned about weather science, clouds, water cycles, precipitation and barometric pressure, just to name a few. Grant Weyman also plans and shares experiments and demonstrations with the school groups, while utilizing the museum's many educational backdrops.

Weather Lab has also created an Internet web site on [www.ksl.com](http://www.ksl.com). Within the site one can find information in such areas as "ask the Meteorologist," weather folklore, weather games, weather experiments, weather safety and quick weather facts. Also, students and parents can click on and see "streaming" video of previously aired segments.

Weather Lab meets the education and environment ascertainment.

## THIRD QUARTER ASCERTAINMENTS

Greg James met with Sheriff Jim Winder on July 10. They discussed the following:

- The consolidation of police and fire to save money.
- Elderly Abuse, physical, financial and emotional. His cases have gone up from about six a year to 15 or 16 per month. He thinks the economy, the reduction of funding for Adult Protective Services and a general lack of respect for the elderly are parts of the problem.
- Sexual assault is on the increase, particularly as it relates to date rape, and the expectations of young men in the dating environment. Parental influence and peer pressure seemed to be his greatest concerns. He signed the recent Pugh study indicating that young people morals have changed. He also indicated that only 20% of these cases are believed to be reported.
- Ottawa Jail study. A city approximately the same size as Salt Lake County does very well with a 600 person jail. They use other techniques such as drug intervention, counseling and in jail administrative courts to reduce problems and “keep the bad guys” in jail. He senses that the Justice Court system is contributing significantly to the problem because they issue bench warrants for so many things. He seems to think too many “fairly good people” are in jail and too many bad ones are on the streets.
- CIT Crisis Intervention Teams Training. A two week training program for City Police and Sheriff’s on dealing with psychiatric confrontations in law enforcement. There is currently no program like this for POST. There is no on-going training for this or a requirement for such training. He has implemented it in the SLC Jail and is the first to do a program like this in the nation. Incidents of forcible confrontation are down well over 50% when officers have been trained. It pays just as big a dividend in the field. Police Departments and Sheriff’s offices are on their own to create such a program. Maybe we should find out why POST doesn’t offer an on-going training and certification in this area.

Bob Johnson met with Primary Children’s Medical Center Board on September 30. They discussed NIH1 and the hospital’s emergency plan.
